



# ”התקשרות היחידה... אצל רבי יחיד”

This *Ksav-Yad* was originally written by the Rebbe as a postscript in a letter to Reb Bentzion Shemtov, dated 13 Elul, 5709.

In this letter, sent along with the “*Kuntreis Chai Elul-Gimmel D’Slichos*”, the Rebbe urges Reb Bentzion to maximize the *Kuntreis’* lesson, and connect more *Yidden* with *Elokus* by bringing them to the Rebbe for *Yechidus*.

Perhaps most amazing of all, is the Rebbe’s clear assertion that by merely writing to the Rebbe, one accomplishes the same connection with him as though he had actually had a *Yechidus*, thereby bonding the innermost part of his *Neshomah* (*Yechidah*) with the Rebbe. Enclosed is the *Kuntreis* for *Chai Elul* and the third day of *Selichos* which was recently published. You will undoubtedly share it with people at large in the most appropriate manner. Your goal should be to make from the many (“*Rabbim*”)- one (“*Yochid*”). This is accomplished by establishing a connection [on the level of] *Yechidah* through the medium of [their] *Yechidus* with the one Rebbe (this is possible even in writing) and [in this way,] to [Hashem], *Yechido shel olam*, [“the quintessence of Oneness in the world”].
