
At 2:00 p.m. the Rebbe leaves for the Ohel, returning to 770 at 6:15 pm.





Shortly after returning, the Rebbe davens Mincha, immediately followed by Maariv, when the Rebbe davens at the *amud* for Yud Shevat.







At approximately 6:55, the Rebbe began distributing the maamar Baruch She'asa Nissim 56641* printed specially for the occasion, along with two dollars, to men, women and children, near the entrance to his room.
